

- 1. Deadline for scholarship applications is March 31, 2024 (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to the criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to the application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will not be accepted. You may also download a copy of the application online: *cchtrine.org/scholarships/*
- 4. You will be notified by mail, in May, regarding the status of your application.

Purpose: The Christian Campus House believes in the value and benefits of young people who exemplify a high level of character and use it to lead others. Professor Amy Nicholls (July 25, 1971 – October 11, 2019), former Dean of the Jannen School of Arts and Science embodied the fullest sense of this scholarship. Her dedication to students, the university and her faith were truly special. CCH wishes to honor her memory by awarding such students with a scholarship for their first year of schooling at Trine University.

Award Components: Each year, the Board of Directors for the Christian Campus House will select one incoming freshman who will be attending Trine University to be the recipient of a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.

Award Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be accepted and have sent their deposit to Trine University.
- 2. Applicant must be a full-time student and a freshman for the 2024-2025 school year.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- 2. Two (2) character references in the form of a letter of recommendation.
- 3. A copy of your most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. A copy of your acceptance letter from Trine University.
- 5. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the question on the enclosed essay form.

What is your strongest character quality and how have you been able to use it to lead others? [600 words or less]

Deadline for the application is **March 31**, **2024**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered. No emailed or incomplete applications will be considered.

Announcement of Scholarship Recipients: You will receive notification by the end of May, and the presentation of your scholarship will be scheduled.

Special Provision: Scholarship funds will be issued directly to Trine University.
